John Macfarlane's Nutcracker Theatre

To assemble the theatre:

- 1. Unpack all parts and lay them out on a table
- 2. Assemble the stage with the proscenium first
- 3. Open the support arms out and fold down the stage floor
- 4. Carefully slot the two right angle arms into the top and back of the stage floor
- 5. When in position, slot the two arms beneath the stage into the slots at the back of the stage floor for support
- 6. Once assembled, then place the single black support bar into the last slots at the top back of the stage to support both the right angle support arms (the wings)
- 7. The stage sets can now be placed as you wish in any of the remaining slots at the top of the theatre
- 8. The curtain goes into the slots closest to the proscenium (front of the theatre).
- 9. When folding the bases to all the characters, trees and fireplace, please take your time to do this carefully on a flat surface (tip: for the neatest of folds, hold the body of the character, tree or fireplace close the the crease line and then fold carefully by pushing back using the table as a flat surface to create a neat fold)
- 10. Have fun acting out the Nutcracker!
